#### **IMPLICATIONS OF TRAVELLING WITH MULTIPLE PASSPORTS TO THE RUSSIAN FEDERATION**

As per the communique of the Embassy of the Russian Federation in Namibia via the Ministry of International Relations and Cooperation, the Ministry of Home Affairs and Immigration would like to inform the general public that wishes to travel to the Russian Federation are required to have their entry visas endorsed in their valid national passports. In the occurrence where a valid visa is endorsed in an expired passport, one should apply for a new visa to be endorsed into the new passport.

Thus it is highly recommended that all with new national passports, who have valid Russian visas in their previous passports, should apply to Embassies or Consulates of the Russian Federation for new visas before going to the Russian Federation.

#### **NOTICE OF FALSE e-VISA WEBSITES FOR TRAVELING TO TURKEY**

The Ministry of Home Affairs and Immigration wishes to inform the general public that all who wish to travel to the Republic of Turkey by obtaining a visa online are cautioned to be careful of false websites claiming to offer e-Visa for traveling to Turkey. Therefor the public is advised to access the e-Visa through the Turkey's Government official website at [www.evisa.gov.tr](http://www.evisa.gov.tr)

As per the communique of the Embassy of the Republic of Turkey in Namibia via the Ministry of International Relations and Cooperation, all Namibians are eligible to obtain a Turkish visa from Turkish Missions or over e-Visa application System for business and Tourism purposes and can pay the e-Visa fees by a credit card or debit card online.
