THE INTRODUCTION OF SPEED POINT MACHINES

The Ministry of Home Affairs and Immigration wishes to inform the general public that Speed Points have been installed and is in operation at its Head office in Windhoek.

The public have now the options to either pay (for a lost, damage or new documents) with cash or a card.

The cash payment will remain an acceptable means of payment; however the Ministry wishes to encourage the public not to carry large amounts of cash due to safety reasons. The Electronic Payment Transfers (EFTs) and use of the point-of-sale devices are regarded as secured alternate payment methods.

Very soon, the Ministry will roll out this activity to all its regional offices country wide.
