

**Countries and nationals to be issued with visas upon Arrival on all three categories of passports, being ordinary, diplomatic and official/service passports at Hosea Kuutako International Airport for tourism, visiting, or transiting through Namibia**

African countries:

Benin, Burkina Faso, Burundi, Cabo Verde, Cameroon, Central Africa Republic (CAR), Chad, Comoros, Cote d' Ivore, Djibouti, Equatorial Guinea, Eritrea, Gabon, Gambia, Guinea, Guinea Bissau, Liberia, Madagascar, Mauritania, Niger, Rwanda, Sao Tome and Principe, Sierra Leone, Togo, Tunisia, Western Sahara Republic, Uganda

Other countries:

Belarus, Bulgaria, Cambodia, Chile, Czech Republic, Hungary, Mexico, Moldova, Nicaragua, Poland, Romania, Slovakia, South Korea, Venezuela, Vietnam, Thailand, Turkey, United Arab Emirates, Singapore, Ukraine.

Along with this principal decision by the Government, Namibia exempted over 60 countries from visa requirements when their citizens are to visit Namibia for tourism purposes, this are:

Angola, Armenia, Austria, Azerbaijan, Belarus, Belgium, Botswana, Brazil, Canada, Congo Brazzaville (holders of diplomatic and service passports only), Cuba, Denmark, Finland, France, Germany, Ghana (holders of diplomatic and service passport holders only), Hong Kong, Iceland, India (holders of diplomatic and official passport up to three (3) months), Ireland, Italy, Spain, Kazakhstan, Kenya, Kyrgyzstan, Liechtenstein, Lesotho, Luxemburg, Macau (SAR), Malawi, Malaysia, Mauritius, Moldova, Mozambique, Netherlands, New Zealand, Nigeria (holders of diplomatic and official passports up to three (3) months), Norway, Poland (holders of diplomatic and official passport up to three (3) months), Portugal, Russian Federation, Seychelles, Singapore, South Africa, Spain, Swaziland, Sweden, Switzerland, Turkey (holders of diplomatic and official passport only), Turkmenistan, Ukraine, United Kingdom, United State of America, Uzbekistan, Venezuela (holders of diplomatic and official passport only), Zambia and Zimbabwe.
