

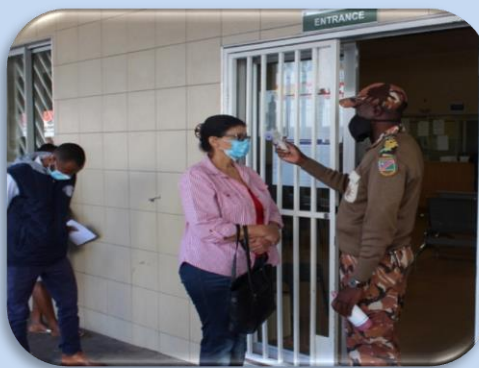
MHAISS measures to curb COVID-19

In keeping with the requirements, Ministry of Home Affairs, Immigration, Safety and Security set measures in place to abide with the Health and Hygiene Guidelines as prescribed under Section 2 of the Regulations of COVID-19.

The Ministry has adopted hygiene and safety measures to ensure that the health of everyone and safeguard of adhering to preventative guidelines which includes social distancing, forceful facemask wearing and public disinfection in the workplace is imposed.

Cleaning and disinfecting offices, maintaining of limited number of customers into the service counters, enforcing of wearing facemasks by both the public and staff members, demarcation of social distance when queuing for services, regular temperature screening and sanitizing before entering the building are some of the measures MHAISS has enforced to safeguard the safety of both employees and clients at the Head Quarter.
